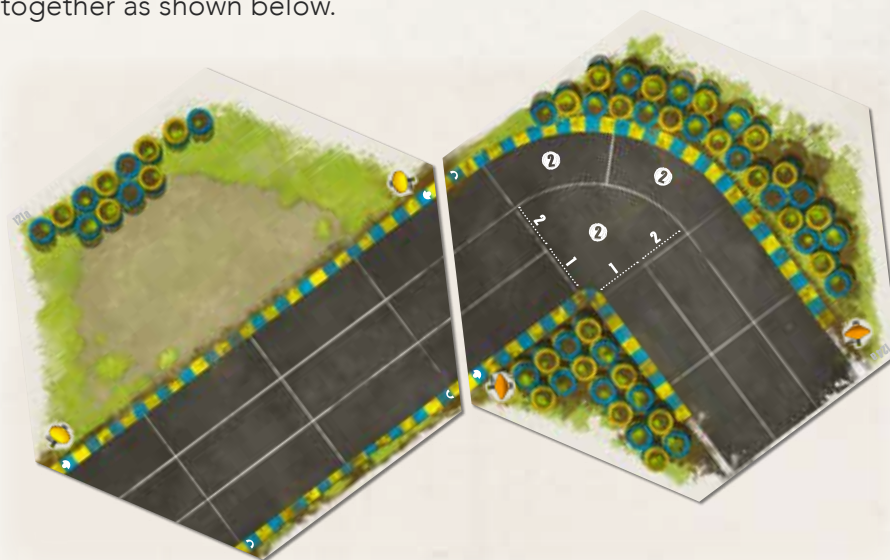

Note that these tracks use the tiles from the core game as well as the new tiles from this expansion and the Championship expansion. These tiles allow you to create new shapes for your tracks. To do so, they have spaces can extend from one tile to another.

You can identify by their special marks, and see how they connect together as shown below.



Contrary to the core box tiles, when these special marks are present the edge of one of these tiles does not count as a separation between spaces.

Note: You will need the tiles from the Championship expansion in order to build the tracks shown in this booklet. You may of course use the tiles included in this set to create your own circuits without the need for any other expansions.
